

- 1. Decided to ask the Human Resources Team- Jon Dracht, Nicole Koetje, and Marilyn Visser- along with a council rep, Doug Mitchell, and Pastor Neil to bring recommendations on renewing a paid Youth Director position, along with responsibilities, hours, salary and avenues to publicize this ministry role.
